
Google Maps

Google Maps is a very useful resource. It has an historical view capability which enables you to view locations as they appeared in the past. It is very useful for researching the history of a business or an address of a person.

A domain name is the main body of a website address. There are many Domain name search websites and 'Whois.com' is just one of them. Information provided by these search tools include names, tel numbers, addresses.
